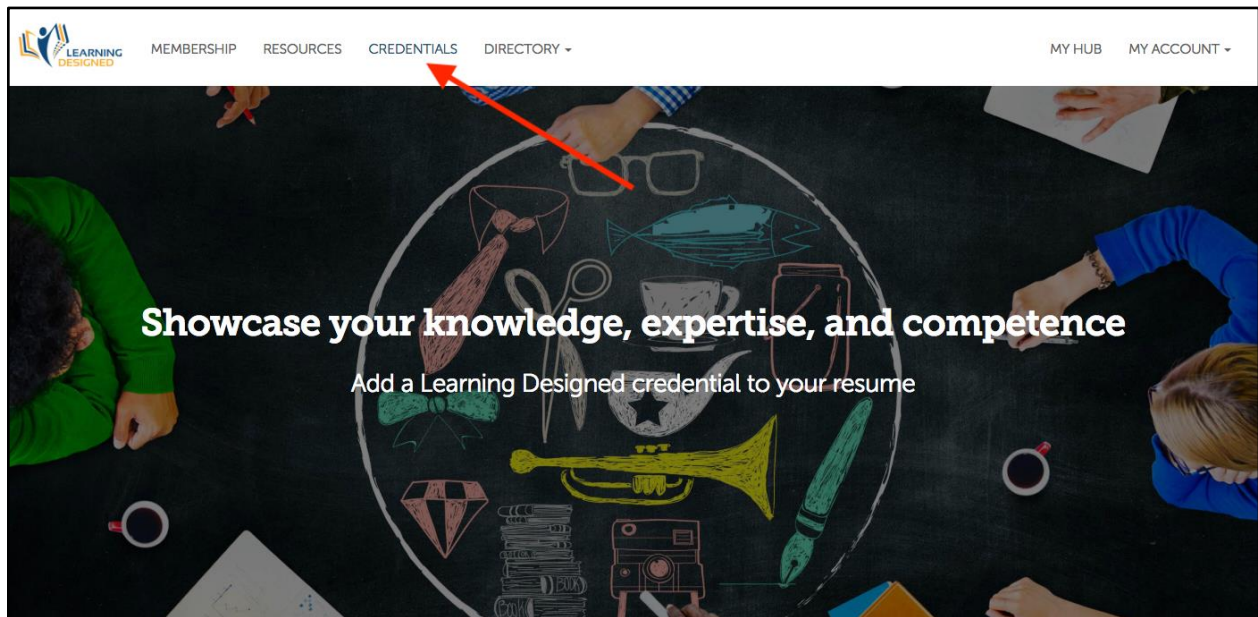



UDL Associate - Level 1 Credential Registration

Evidence Submission

To earn the UDL Associate Credential - Level 1, credential seekers may choose to submit a written and/or recorded response addressing the basic knowledge required to demonstrate an understanding of why UDL is important. (Written responses should not exceed 500 words. Audio/video recorded responses should be a minimum of 3 minutes and no more than 5.) You can find the basic knowledge statements outlined in the Associate Credential - Level 1 rubric. Your submission should be a reflective narrative, demonstrating, in your own words, your understanding of the identified UDL Associate Credential - Level 1 rubric components. Performing a careful review of the UDL Associate Credential - Level 1 rubric prior to submission will help ensure your response thoroughly addresses the evaluation criteria, specifically the key words underlined in each component. You can view a copy of the rubric by clicking the button below. After reviewing the rubric, click on the back button in your browser to return to this submission page. (Note: You may want to save or print the rubric for convenient reference.)
