What is the sequence, or steps, in the activity?

1. Choose a magazine
2. Choose stories
3. Read opening to story (then stop and wait for direction)
4. Talk about stories

VOCABULARY NEEDS:

Vocabulary for “opening” the activity

- I - see - that
- I - want - that

Vocabulary for “making choices”

- I - want - look/see
- I - want - more
- I - want - that
- Look - here
- I - want - “fringe” (story about fashion, story about pets, story about music story about sports, etc.)

Vocabulary for “directing action” and/or indicating the next step in the sequence

- I/You – look
- Stop
- More
- Wait
- Break

Vocabulary for “making comments”

- I – like – that
- I – don’t – like – that
- Mine

Vocabulary for “asking or answering questions”

- Yes
- No
- You – want - that?
- You – see - that?
- You - like - that?
- What – that?

Vocabulary for “closing” the activity

- All done
